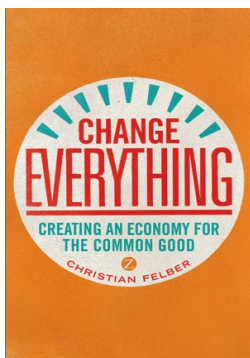




Christian Felber ist an Austrian **activist, book writer, university lecturer, international speaker** and **contemporary dancer**. He initiated the **Economy for the Common Good movement** and the project **Bank for the Common Good**. He has written 15 books and given inspiring speeches in so far 25 countries in Europe and other continents, including at the European Parliament, the Chilean government or TEDx.

The **Economy for the Common Good** is a young social movement and a concrete model for a new economy that started five years ago in Austria. It is supported by over 2000 companies from 40 nations and more than 100 local groups all over Europe and South America so far. The ECG collaborates with economic, political and cultural pioneers such as companies, municipalities and universities (e. g. the international outdoor company VAUDE, Sparda Bank Munich, organic tea producer Sonnentor, the public University for Applied Sciences Burgenland or the Lausanne Business School).

The English edition of the Economy for the Common Good was published in June 2015 under the title **“Change Everything. Creating an Economy for the Common Good”**.



The foreword has been written by nobel laureate **Eric Maskin**: “Christian Felber thinks big. Not content with marginal change, he proposes a thorough overhaul of our capitalist system. In his world, companies still earn profits. But they are driven not by revenues and costs (...)”.

Christian Felber will start a **US campaign this summer** to present his book and to introduce the Economy for the Common Good movement in North America. **The three-month** media campaign in the US will **include a ten-day tour with Christian in mid-September**. Before this exciting tour begins, a crowd-funding campaign will run from June 1st to June 30th in order to raise funds for this ambitious project.
